| <u>Virtual Project Grants for the General Public (VPG)</u> | at least six weeks before the start date | \$1,000 min \$3,000 max No match required | Nonprofit arts organizations incorporated in Nebraska that are federally tax-exempt. | Provides access to funds that support a variety of arts projects that are conducted online such as online exhibitions, performances, poetry readings, or development of new artworks. | Arts organizations may apply for up to one Virtual Arts Project Grant or one Recovery Grant application during the NAC fiscal year (July 1 - June 30), but may not apply in both categories. NAC Basic Support grantees, PreK-12 schools, colleges, public agencies, subdivisions of government or religious organizations are not eligible to apply. |
| <u>Virtual Project Grants for Schools (VPS)</u> | at least six weeks before the start date | \$1,000 min \$3,000 max No match required | Nonprofit arts organizations incorporated in Nebraska that are federally tax-exempt. NAC Basic Support Grantees are eligible for the Virtual Arts Projects for Schools (VPS) category. | Provides support for development and implementation of educational arts projects for preK-12 schools that are conducted online such as workshops, performances, or guided art tours. | Arts organizations may apply for up to one Virtual Arts Project Grant application or one Recovery Grant during the NAC fiscal year (July 1 - June 30), but may not apply in both categories. PreK-12 accredited schools, colleges, public agencies, subdivisions of government or religious organizations are not eligible to apply. |
| <u>Virtual Artists in Schools/Communities (AiS/C)</u> | at least six weeks before the start date | \$200 - \$1,100 depending on number of visits No match required | Nonprofit organizations incorporated in Nebraska that are federally tax-exempt, public agencies and subdivisions of governmental agencies, including PreK-12 accredited schools. | Provides funds to hire artists from the NAC Teaching Artist Roster to lead creative and educational demonstrations or guided arts activities. Sponsors may hire an artist for Visits consisting of three virtual sessions or a Residency consisting of ten or more virtual sessions. | Applicants may apply more than once during the NAC fiscal year (June 1 – July 30), but may not apply to hire the same artist for more than one AiS/C Residency . |
| <u>Virtual Nebraska Touring Program (NTP)</u> | at least six weeks before the start date | Up to \$1,000 per contract No match required | Nonprofit organizations incorporated in Nebraska that are federally tax-exempt, public agencies and subdivisions of governmental agencies, including PreK-12 accredited schools. | Help sponsor organizations fund virtual performances or exhibits selected from the NAC Touring Roster, listed on the NAC website. | Sponsors may not select artists or events based in the sponsor's city or within a thirty mile radius. |
| <u>Virtual Presenting the State Poet</u> | at least six weeks before the start date | \$1,000 max No match required | Nonprofit organizations incorporated in Nebraska that are federally tax-exempt, public agencies and subdivisions of governmental agencies, including PreK-12 accredited schools. | Virtual Presenting the State Poet grants provide financial assistance to host virtual events featuring the Nebraska State Poet. | College and university applications may be funded only when participation by the public is sought in significant numbers. An organization is limited to one application per fiscal year. |

Applicants may submit more than one application per year as long as the maximum amount is not exceeded within the fiscal year.</p> |
| <p>Arts Accessibility Grants for Improvement Projects</p> | <p>LOIs due at least 12 weeks before project start date</p> | <p>\$5,000 max No match required</p> | <p>Nonprofit arts organizations incorporated in Nebraska that are federally tax-exempt.</p> | <p>Provide funds to improve access to art organization's existing programs or facility for patrons with disabilities.</p> | <p>PreK-12 accredited schools, colleges, public agencies, subdivisions of government or religious organizations are not eligible to apply.</p> |
| <p>Micro Grants</p> | <p>LOIs due at least 6 weeks before the start date</p> | <p>\$500 max No match required</p> | <p>Artists residing in Nebraska who actively pursue artmaking and have been impacted by COVID</p> | <p>Provide need-based financial support to assist artists impacted by Covid-19 in developing their virtual and marketing presence.</p> | <p>Nonprofit organizations, preK-12 accredited schools, colleges, public agencies, subdivisions of government or religious organizations are not eligible to apply. Pre-K-12 schools, colleges, public agencies, subdivisions of government or religious organizations are not eligible to apply.</p> |
